

# Star in a Star Quilted Wall Hanging

Featuring the *Easy Star and Geese Ruler*

Quilt Size: 27½" x 27½" /

Skill Level: Easy, Fun (Beginner)



I'll teach you my very own signature technique for making Flying Geese and Sawtooth Star blocks with *absolutely perfect points* using **NO MATH, NO WASTED FABRIC**, and **NO STRESS!** You'll cut and piece this fast and fun one-block-wonder quilt in an afternoon from start to finish. This is the perfect project for both beginners and quilters with more advanced skills, and a great opportunity to perfect your ¼" seam and practice free motion meandering skills (if time permits.) Use fabrics you have on hand, or choose fabrics with that special someone in mind for a lovely gift!

## Supplies needed:

- ✓ **Easy Star and Geese Ruler** (*I will have rulers available for use in class or for purchase at a special discounted rate for NQA attendees.*)
- ✓ 6" x 24" ruler
- ✓ Rotary cutter and mat
- ✓ Sewing machine in good working condition
- ✓ ¼" piecing foot with guide (optional, but highly encouraged!)
- ✓ Free motion quilting foot
- ✓ Basic sewing supplies, including neutral thread for piecing and thread for machine quilting, scissors, seam ripper, etc.
- ✓ Fabrics washed and pressed. (Spray sizing recommended.)

FABRIC	YARDS
<b>Fabric #1</b> Center Star (Medium)	¼ yd. or 1 fat quarter
<b>Fabric #2</b> Outer Star (Dark)	¼ yd. or 1 fat quarter
<b>Fabric #3</b> Background (Light)	1/3 yd.
<b>Fabric #4</b> Border (Multi-color)	½ yd.
<b>Fabric #5</b> Binding	1/3 yd.
<b>Fabric #6</b> Batting and backing	1 yd.
