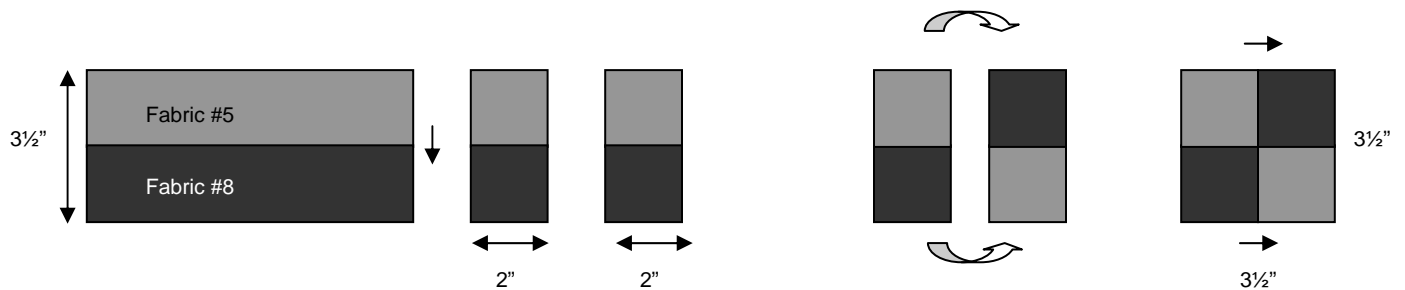


STEP 2

- Lightly press a 2" - #5 strip and a 2" - #8 strip RST to make them lightly cling.
- Sew $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam on long side of strip unit. Press strip closed, then open and press seam toward #8.
- Repeat process with remaining 2" - #5 / #8 strips.
- Cut into 80 (eighty) 2" units.
- Rotate one unit and place RST on top of another unit, butting seams together.
- Sew two units together to form a four-patch square.
- Press each unit closed first, then open and press seam to one side.
- Four-patch units should measure $3\frac{1}{2}$ " square.
- Square up four-patch units if necessary.
- Make a total of 40 - $3\frac{1}{2}$ " - #5 / #8 four-patch units
