## Amazing Dresden Applique! by Kimberly Einmo

Quilt size: 46" x 46" / finished block size: 7" / 36 total blocks Skill level: Skilled beginner - intermediate

## Supply List:

- Fabric as outlined in chart below
- 45 mm (or larger) rotary cutter with a sharp new blade
- Rotary mat
- 50 wt. cotton thread in neutral shade for piecing
- 50 wt. cotton thread for machine appliqué to match your Dresden and circle fabrics
- 40 wt. cotton threads for decorative stitching at least three different colors with contrast

   NO polyester thread, please!
- Appli-Glue (by Jilily Studios) or you can use a glue stick
- 1 yd. lightweight fusible web
- Package of tear-away (or temporary) stabilizer on a roll
- · Basic sewing supplies such as scissors, straight pins, general sewing supplies, seam ripper
- Binding, batting and backing not needed for class

FABRIC		CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS
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#1 - Background	2 yds	• 8 strips; cut 36 - 7 <sup>1</sup> / <sub>2</sub> " squares (must be accurate)
#2 - Long wedges	1¼ yds	<ul> <li>Cut into 23 pieces measuring approximately (no smaller than) 7" x 9"</li> </ul>
#3 - Short wedges	1¼ yds	<ul> <li>Cut into 22 pieces measuring approximately (no smaller than) 7" x 9"</li> </ul>
#4 – Circles and arcs	¼ yd	<ul> <li>Fuse your fabric with fusible web before cutting</li> <li>Cut 5 pieces measuring approximately (no smaller than) 5" x 9"</li> </ul>
Binding	½ yd	<ul> <li>Cut 5 - 2½" strips; piece together for binding (not needed for class)</li> </ul>
Batting		• 56" x 56" (not needed for class)
Backing	3½ yds	• 2 panels 29" x 56" (not needed for class)
