
# Easy Star and Geese Ruler



Cut fabric strips according to the *finished size* of flying geese units listed on the left side of Side A on the ruler. Two layers of fabric strips work best to avoid slippage. More than four layers results in loss of cutting accuracy.

#### Side A (Magenta)


Use Side A to cut "geese" units (quarter-square triangles) from strips.





## Side B (Mint Green)

Fold fabric strip RST (right sides together) and use Side B to cut "wing" units (half-square triangles) from strips. This results in mirror image wing units.



## Flying Geese Assembly



Match notched edge of wing unit to notched edge of geese unit, place RST and sew. Press seam allowance towards wing unit. Match notched of opposite side wing unit to geese unit, place RST and sew. Press seam allowance towards wing unit. Trim dog ears.
