- EZ Flying Geese Ruler by Kimberly Einmo.
- EZ Jelly Roll Ruler by Kimberly Einmo. Optional.
- 45 or 60 mm Rotary cutter. Splurge on a new blade!
- Cutting mat
- Rotary cutting ruler. Bring your favorite size.
- Square ruler, 10½" or larger (optional).
- 50 wt. cotton sewing thread to match your background fabric.
- BSS including anything that will make your classroom sewing experience more enjoyable!


### **Fabric Requirements and Instructions**


- Directions and instructions given in class are for the EZ Flying Geese Ruler method.
- Yardage amounts are provided for complete quilt. The complete pattern will be provided in class.
- Choose fabrics and color combinations you LOVE. Create a legend of your fabrics on the fabric cutting table. Glue, staple or tape a small piece of each fabric in the square next to the corresponding fabric number. You'll be very glad you took the time to do this!
- Cut all strips selvage to selvage / width of fabric (WOF).

#### **BRING ALL FABRICS TO CLASS!**

FABRIC	YARDS	CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS	LEGEND OF YOUR FABRICS
#1 - Background	2½ yds	<ul><li>1 - 4½" strip.</li><li>2 - 2½" strips.</li></ul>	
#2 - Blue/white print	3/8 yd	• Cut 2 – 4½" strips; subcut 12 – 4½" x 4½" squares.	
#3 - Medium blue	¼ yd	• Cut 1 − 2½" strip.	
#4 - Medium/dark blue	¼ yd	• Cut 1 − 2½" strip.	
#5 - Dark blue	½ yd	• Cut 1 − 4½" strip.	
#6 - Light green	1/8 yd	• 1 - 2½" strip.	
#7 - Medium/light green	1/8 yd	• 1 - 2½" strip.	
#8 - Bright olive green	¼ yd	• 1 - 4½" strip.	
#9 - Dark blue green	¼ yd	• Cut 1 - 41/2" strip.	
#10 - Light green print	¼ yd	<ul> <li>1 - 4½" strip; subcut 4 – 4½" x</li> <li>4½" squares.</li> </ul>
