**Quilt Size: Quilt Size: 41" x 41" / Block Size: 10" Finished**

In this high-energy class, Kimberly will share her precision cutting and piecing methods while keeping you entertained with her own style of humor and sunny disposition. Her signature technique features NO MATH, NO WASTED FABRIC, and NO STRESS using her amazing **EZ Flying Geese Ruler**. You'll love this magic method for piecing perfect flying geese, half-square triangle units and stars while constructing a gorgeous quilt top. But this is only where the fun begins! She share her signature secret for how to expertly piece pinwheels with perfect points *without* the use of pins. (*Really!*) The creative energy and ingenuity will flow like fresh autumn breezes and you'll create a fabulous wall hanging that looks complex; only you will know how easy it is to construct using straight-set blocks.



### **Supplies Needed:**

- **EZ Flying Geese Ruler** by Kimberly Einmo – Available to purchase from Kimberly at a discount in class
- Sewing machine in good working condition
- 45mm (or larger) rotary cutter (treat yourself to a new, sharp blade) and rotary mat
- 4" x 18" ruler
- 10" square ruler (*optional*)
- 50 wt. cotton thread in neutral
- Basic sewing supplies, such as seam ripper, scissors, straight pins, etc.

### **Fabric requirements:**

Colors listed in parentheses are for planning placement purposes only. Choose your favorite fabrics and color combinations and follow the color **VALUES** as listed in the chart carefully. Be sure there is good contrast so the secondary designs emerge when blocks are set together.

Cut all strips selvage to selvage / width of fabric (WOF)

Fabric #2	<b>LIGHT</b> <i>(Light background)</i>	1 yd	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Cut 1 – 5½” strip</li> <li>• Cut 3 – 5½” strips</li> <li>• Cut 2 – 3” strips</li> </ul>
Fabric #3	<b>MEDIUM LIGHT</b> <i>(Yellow - small pinwheels)</i>	¼ yd	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Cut 2 – 3” strips</li> </ul>
Fabric #4	<b>MEDIUM</b> <i>(Large corner twister)</i>	¼ yd	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Cut 1 – 5½” strip</li> <li>• Cut 1 – 3” strip</li> </ul>
Fabric #5	<b>MEDIUM</b> <i>(Large corner twister)</i>	¼ yd	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Cut 1 – 5½” strip</li> <li>• Cut 1 – 3” strip</li> </ul>
Fabric #6	<b>MEDIUM</b> <i>(Large corner twister)</i>	¼ yd	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Cut 1 – 5½” strip</li> <li>• Cut 1 – 3” strip</li> </ul>
Fabric #7	<b>MEDIUM</b> <i>(Large corner twister)</i>	¼ yd	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Cut 1 – 5½” strip</li> <li>• Cut 1 – 3” strip</li> </ul>
Fabric #8	<b>DARK</b> <i>(Large center twister)</i>	5/8 yd	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Cut 1 – 5½” strip</li> <li>• Cut 1 – 3” strip</li> <li>• Cut 5 – 2¼” strips for binding</li> </ul>
Backing		1¼ yd	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 44” x 44”</li> </ul>
Batting		---	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 44” x 44”</li> </ul>
