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SUPPLIES NEEDED:


- EZ Jelly Roll Ruler by Kimberly Einmo
- Rotary cutter (45 or 60mm) Buy a new blade
- · Medium-size rotary mat
- Rotary cutting ruler (bring your favorite size ruler for cutting yardage and strips)
- 10½" (or larger) square ruler
- A Post-It note pad is especially helpful
- Neutral sewing thread to match your background fabric
- Basic Sewing Supplies such as sewing scissors, straight pins, general sewing supplies, seam ripper
- Bring anything you might need to make your classroom experience more efficient, stress-free, and enjoyable! (Think: a portable light, extension cord, a cushion to sit on, magnifying or reading glasses, something to drink in a cup with a spill proof lid, chocolate... and most importantly, a sense of fun!)



Cutting

You can use one Jelly Roll bundle OR 11 (or up to 22) fat quarters PLUS one background fabric

- Plan your fabric placement by following the numbers in the chart as shown.
- Fabric #1 is the background fabric.
- Fabrics #2 and #3 may be the same fabric or very similar in color and value. These create the "radiant" or medium blue diamonds as shown.
- Fabrics #4 and #6 are the inside pinwheels, yellow and dark blue as shown.
- Fabric #5 is the outer star points, orange as shown.



FABRIC	YARDS	INSTRUCTIONS
Fabric #1 - Background Fabric (Choose a tone on tone or solid that has strong contrast from the strips)	1½ yds	 Cut 1 – 5¼" strip; subcut 4 – 5¼" squares. Cut each square once diagonally to yield 8 A triangles. Cut 1 – 6¾" strip; subcut 4 – 6¾" squares. Cut each square once diagonally to yield 8 B triangles. Bring remaining fabric to be cut in class.
 Fabrics #2 and #3 Fabrics #4, #5, and #6 	¾ yards total	To make this quilt, please have a variety of at least 11 different fabrics. These will be used in the star and also in the flying geese border. • Cut 1 - 2½" x 22" strip from each. • Cut 1 - 2½" x 22" strip from each. Bring remaining fabrics to be cut in class.
Backing	1¼ yds	Not needed for class.
