Cutting Instructions are recommended for use with **EZ Jelly Roll Ruler by Kimberly Einmo**

FABRIC	YARDS	INSTRUCTIONS
<b>1 Jelly Roll or 40 – 2½" strips</b> <i>(Use a precut bundle of strips or fabric from your stash or scraps!)</i>	2½ yds	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>To make this quilt, please have a variety of <b>at least 20 different fabrics</b> for a total of 40 – 2½" strips total. (Fabric strips can be repeated twice.)</li> <li>Bring all strips to class</li> </ul>
<b>Background Fabric</b> <i>(Choose a tone on tone or solid that has strong contrast from the strips)</i>	3½ yds	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Cut 5 – 5" strips; subcut 36 – 5" squares. Cut each square once diagonally to yield 72 A triangles</li> <li>Cut 6 – 6 5/8" strips; subcut 36 – 6 5/8" squares. Cut each square once diagonally to yield 72 B triangles</li> <li>Cut 8 – 5½" strips and piece together for borders</li> </ul>
<b>Backing</b>	4¼ yds	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>2 panels 36" x 76"</li> </ul>
<b>Batting</b>		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>76" x 76"</li> </ul>
<b>Binding</b>	¾ yd	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Cut 8 – 2¼" strips; piece together to make single fold, straight grain binding</li> </ul>

## **SUPPLIES NEEDED:**

*(Note: I'll have some of the **EZ Jelly Roll Rulers** on hand to lend in class for you to try and for sale at a special guild discount.)*

- **EZ Jelly Roll Ruler by Kimberly Einmo**
- Fabric strips as outlined in Fabric Requirements chart below
- 45 mm (or larger) rotary cutter
- Rotary mat
- Ruler: 6" x 24" or 4" x 18" plus 10½" (or larger) square ruler *(optional, but very helpful for squaring up blocks)*
- Neutral sewing thread in ecru or light gray
- Basic Sewing Supplies such as sewing scissors, straight pins, general sewing supplies, seam ripper Items on general supply list (as provided)
- Bring anything you might need to make your classroom experience more efficient, stress-free, and enjoyable! *(Think: a portable light, extension cord, a cushion to sit on, magnifying or reading glasses, something to drink in a cup with a spill proof lid, chocolate... and most importantly, a sense of fun!)*
