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Quilt size: 70" x 70"

Block size: 10" unfinished

Skill level: Intermediate

### Supply List

- **EZ Jelly Roll Ruler or Precision Precuts Ruler** by Kimberly Einmo. *Rulers available in class at a discount. If you use your own ruler, it must have a 45 degree line.*
- 45 or 60 mm rotary cutter. Splurge on a new blade for class!
- Cutting mat larger than 12"
- 50 wt. cotton sewing thread to match your background fabric.
- At least one flat head flower pin.
- Basic sewing supplies including anything that will make your classroom sewing experience more enjoyable.



FABRIC	YARDS	INSTRUCTIONS
<b>1 Jelly Roll or 40 – 2½" strips</b> <i>(Use a precut bundle of strips or 2½" fabric from your stash).</i>	2½ yards.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• To make this quilt, please have a variety of <b>at least 20 different fabrics</b> for a total of 40 – 2½" strips.</li> <li>• Fabric strips can be repeated twice. 40 different strips are encouraged. Strips from fat quarters are not recommended. Bring all strips to class.</li> </ul>
<b>Background Fabric</b> <i>(Choose a tone on tone or solid that has strong contrast from the strips)</i>	3½ yards.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Cut 5 – 5¼" strips; subcut 36 – 5¼" squares. Cut each square once diagonally to yield 72 A triangles.</li> <li>• Cut 6 – 6¾" strips; subcut 36 – 6¾" squares. Cut each square once diagonally to yield 72 B triangles.</li> </ul>
