Supply List

- **Precision Jelly Roll Ruler OR Precision Precuts Ruler** by Kimberly Einmo. *Rulers will be available through Kimberly, in person.*
- **Sewing machine in excellent working condition!**
- 1/4" piecing foot is essential
- Power cord and foot pedal for your machine.
- 45 mm or 60 mm rotary cutter. *Change your blade before class!*
- Cutting mat larger than 12"
- 50 wt. cotton sewing thread to match your background fabric.
- At least one flat head flower pin.
- Basic sewing supplies including anything that will make your classroom sewing experience more enjoyable.
- Fabrics as listed below.



FABRIC	YARDS	INSTRUCTIONS
1 Jelly Roll or 40 – 2½" strips <i>(Use a precut bundle of strips or 2½" fabric from your stash).</i>	2½ yards.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • To make this quilt, please have a variety of at least 20 different fabrics for a total of 40 – 2½" strips. • Fabric strips can be repeated twice. 40 different strips are encouraged. Strips from fat quarters are not recommended. Bring all strips to class.
Background Fabric <i>(Choose a tone on tone or solid that has strong contrast from the strips)</i>	3½ yards.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Cut 5 – 5¼" strips; subcut 36 – 5¼" squares. Cut each square once diagonally to yield 72 A triangles. • Cut 6 – 6¾" strips; subcut 36 – 6¾" squares. Cut each square once diagonally to yield 72 B triangles.
