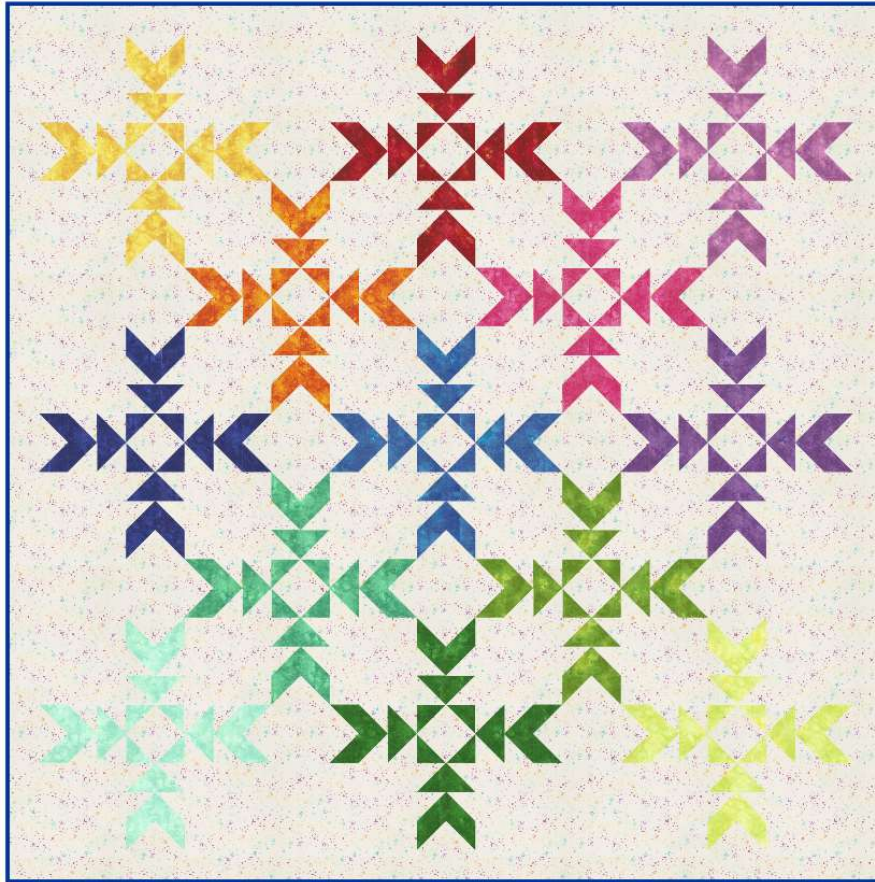


Fractured Flying Geese

FABRIC	YARDAGE	CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS
Fabric #1 Blocks	13 different fabrics of 2½" strips	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Strips must be AT LEAST 40" in length. Follow directions below <i>exactly as written</i> to cut your strips. <i>You will use every bit of the strip to make one block.</i>
Fabric #2 Background	¾ yards	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Cut 2 – 3½" strips. From these strips, cut 13 – 3½" x 3½" squares. • Cut 17 – 2½" strips. • Cut 4 – 9¾" strips. From these strips, cut 13 – 9¾" x 9¾" squares and cut these squares 2x diagonally to yield 52 C triangles. <i>For class, bring 16 C triangles.</i> • Cut 2 – 21" x 21" squares. Cut these squares 2x diagonally to yield 8 side setting triangles. <i>Not needed for class.</i> • Cut 2 – 10¾" x 10¾" squares. Cut these squares 1x diagonally to yield 4 corner setting triangles. <i>Not needed for class.</i>
