## Supply List

- Precision Precuts Ruler by Kimberly Einmo. You can purchase at www.kimberlyeinmo.com or in class.
- Precision Jelly Roll Ruler by Kimberly Einmo is also very helpful, but optional.
- 45 or 60 mm Rotary cutter. Splurge on a new blade!
- Cutting mat
- 50 wt. cotton sewing thread to match your background fabric.
- BSS including anything that will make your classroom sewing experience more enjoyable!


| FABRIC | YARDS | INSTRUCTIONS |

| 1 Jelly Roll or 40-21/2" strips (Use a precut bundle of strips or $2^{1 / 21}$ fabric from your stash). | $2^{11 / 2}$ yards. | - To make this quilt, please have a variety of at least 20 different fabrics for a total of $40-2^{1 / 2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips. (Fabric strips can be repeated twice. 40 different fabrics are encouraged!) <br> - Strips from fat quarters can be used but you will need at least 20 different fabrics and the equivalent of 40 $21 / 2$ " strips. Bring all strips to class. |
| Background Fabric (Choose a tone on tone or solid that has strong contrast from the strips) | $31 / 2$ yards. | - Cut $5-5^{1 / 4 " ~ s t r i p s ; ~ s u b c u t ~} 36-51 / 4 "$ squares. Cut each square once diagonally to yield 72 A triangles <br> - Cut $6-63 / 4$ " strips; subcut $36-63 / 4$ " squares. Cut each square once diagonally to yield 72 B triangles <br> - Save remaining fabric for outer borders. |
