- 45 or 60 mm Rotary cutter. Splurge on a new blade!
- Cutting mat
- 50 wt. cotton sewing thread to match your background fabric.
- BSS including anything that will make your classroom sewing experience more enjoyable!



FABRIC	YARDS	INSTRUCTIONS
1 Jelly Roll or 40 – 2½" strips (Use a precut bundle of strips or 2½" fabric from your stash).	2½ yards.	 To make this quilt, please have a variety of at least 20 different fabrics for a total of 40 – 2½" strips. (Fabric strips can be repeated twice. 40 different fabrics are encouraged!) Strips from fat quarters can be used but you will need at least 20 different fabrics and the equivalent of 40 – 2½" strips. Bring all strips to class.
Background Fabric (Choose a tone on tone or solid that has strong contrast from the strips)	3½ yards.	 Cut 5 - 5½" strips; subcut 36 - 5½" squares. Cut each square once diagonally to yield 72 A triangles Cut 6 - 6¾" strips; subcut 36 - 6¾" squares. Cut each square once diagonally to yield 72 B triangles Save remaining fabric for outer borders.
