### Supply List

- **Precision Precuts Ruler** by Kimberly Einmo. You can purchase at [www.kimberlyeinmo.com](http://www.kimberlyeinmo.com) or in class.
- **Precision Jelly Roll Ruler** by Kimberly Einmo is also very helpful, but optional.
- 45 or 60 mm Rotary cutter. Splurge on a new blade!
- Cutting mat
- 50 wt. cotton sewing thread to match your background fabric.
- BSS including anything that will make your classroom sewing experience more enjoyable!



FABRIC	YARDS	INSTRUCTIONS
<b>1 Jelly Roll or 40 – 2½" strips</b> <i>(Use a precut bundle of strips or 2½" fabric from your stash).</i>	2½ yards.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• To make this quilt, please have a variety of <b>at least 20 different fabrics</b> for a total of 40 – 2½" strips. (Fabric strips can be repeated twice. 40 different fabrics are encouraged!)</li> <li>• Strips from fat quarters can be used but you will need at least 20 different fabrics and the equivalent of 40 – 2½" strips. Bring all strips to class.</li> </ul>
<b>Background Fabric</b> <i>(Choose a tone on tone or solid that has strong contrast from the strips)</i>	3½ yards.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Cut 5 – 5¼" strips; subcut 36 – 5¼" squares. Cut each square once diagonally to yield 72 A triangles</li> <li>• Cut 6 – 6¾" strips; subcut 36 – 6¾" squares. Cut each square once diagonally to yield 72 B triangles</li> <li>• Save remaining fabric for outer borders.</li> </ul>
