

Fractured Flying Geese

- **Precision Flying Geese & HST Ruler** by Kimberly Einmo **REQUIRED** plus one of either the **Precision Precuts Ruler or** the **Precision Jelly Roll Ruler** by Kimberly Einmo (optional).
- 45mm or 60mm rotary cutter (please have a sharp, new blade).
- Cutting mat, larger than 12" square
- 50 wt. cotton sewing thread in a neutral color
- Basic sewing supplies

Fabric Requirements and Instructions

Cutting and construction methods are written specifically for the **Precision Flying Geese & HST Ruler (PFGH)** method. Kimberly's rulers are available prior to the beginning of class from Kimberly or at <u>www.kimberlyeinmo.com/store.</u>

Partial kit of fabrics available for sale from <u>www.kimberlyeinmo.com</u> for \$30. Go to <u>www.kimberlyeinmo.com</u>. Partial kit contains $14 - 2\frac{1}{2}$ " strips of Solidish fabrics. You will need to add your own background fabric.

Note: partial kit contains one additional strip of fabric in case of cutting errors.

FABRIC	YARDAGE	CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS
Fabric #1 Blocks	13 different fabrics of 21⁄2" strips	• Strips must be AT LEAST 40" in length. You will use every bit of the strip to make one block. (It is a good idea to bring at least one extra strip in case you make a cutting error.)
Fabric #2 Background	3¾ yards	 Cut 2 – 3½" strips. From these strips, cut 13 – 3½" x 3½" squares. Cut 17 – 2½" strips. Cut 4 – 9¾" strips. From these strips, cut 13 – 9¾" x 9¾" squares and cut these squares 2x diagonally to yield 52 C triangles. <i>For class, bring at least 16 C triangles.</i> Cut 2 – 21" x 21" squares. Cut these squares 2x diagonally to yield 8 side setting triangles. <i>Not needed for class.</i> Cut 2 – 10¾" x 10¾" squares. Cut these squares 1x diagonally to yield 4 corner setting triangles. <i>Not needed for class.</i>
