# Patriotic Star

Quilt sizes: 18" x 18"

Skill level: Skilled beginner
Show off your love of country and your patriotism! All you need are four fabrics to make this pretty wall or door hanging.

## Supply list:

- Rotary cutter, mat, and ruler.
- 50-wt. cotton thread in a neutral color.
- $1 / 4$ " foot for piecing.
- Precision Precuts Ruler or Precision Jelly Roll Ruler by Kimberly Einmo optional, but recommended. (www.kimberlyeinmo.com)
- Basic sewing supplies including thread snips, straight pins anything that will make your sewing experience more enjoyable!


| FABRIC | YARDAGE | CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS |
| :---: | :---: | :---: |
| \#1 Background | $1 / 2$ yard | - Cut $2-11 / 4$ " strips. (Note: If your strips aren't at least 40 " in length, you may need an additional strip.) <br> - Cut 2-2" strips; cut 32-2" squares. <br> - Cut $1-47 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ strip; cut 2-47/8" squares and cut each square $1 x$ diagonally to yield 4 triangles. Trim remaining strip to $41 / 2$, " and cut $4-41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares. |
| \#2 <br> Center and corner squares Flag print | 1/8 yard | - Cut $1-4 \frac{1}{2}$ " square. <br> - Cut $4-31 / 22^{\prime \prime}$ squares. |
| \#3 <br> Large star point and four-patch units Navy blue | 1/4 yard | - Cut $1-1 \frac{1}{4 \prime \prime}$ " strip. (Note: If your strip isn't at least 40 " in length, you may need an additional strip.) <br> - Cut $1-47 / 8$ " strip; cut $2-47 / 8$ " squares and cut each square $1 x$ diagonally to yield 4 triangles. |
| Small star point and four-patch units Red | $1 / 4$ yard | - Cut $1-1 \frac{1}{4}$ " strip. (Note: If your strip isn't at least 40" in length, you may need an additional strip.) <br> - Cut 4-37/8" squares. |

HST = half-square triangle
RST = right sides together

## Make the following half-square triangles (HSTs):

- Make 4 HSTs using fabrics \#1 and \#3.
- HSTs should measure $41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ unfinished.

Make 4 HSTs
$41 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 4 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime}$
unfinished

- Trim dog ears and square-up if necessary.



## Create star points:

- Mark a diagonal line on the wrong side of the \#4 squares using a Hera marker or erasable ink.
- Place a \#4 square RST on top of a HST aligning the raw edges exactly as shown. (Pay careful attention to the orientation of the HST!)
- Stitch on the diagonal line.
- Trim $1 / 4$ " to the outside of the stitching line.
- Press seam toward \#4 to complete the square. Make 4 units.
- Units should measure $41 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ unfinished. Square-up if necessary.



- Construct 32 four-patch units.
- Press seam open. (I find it helpful to use a Strip Stick to open seams.)
- Four-patch units should measure 2" x 2" unfinished. Square-up if necessary.


2" x 2" unfinished

- Use fabric \#1-2" squares to construct double four-patch units.
- Press seams toward fabric \#1 squares, as shown by arrows.
- Double four-patch units should measure $3^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 3^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime}$ unfinished. Square-up if necessary.


Make 32
$31 / 2{ }^{\prime \prime} \times 31 / 2$ "
unfinished

## Construct the quilt top:

- Arrange the double four-patch units around the center star block, being careful to rotate the units to create the secondary design.
- Add the fabric \#2-31/2" squares in the corners.
- Assemble the quilt top, which should measure $181 / 22^{\prime \prime} \times 181 / 2{ }^{2}$ unfinished.
- Square-up if necessary and quilt as desired.
- Remember to sign and date your quilt with a permanent fabric pen. God bless the USA!
