


Shoo Fly Block for Kimberly Einmo / 9½" x 9½" unfinished

I would be honored if **YOU** would make a going-away block for me! This traditional Shoo Fly block is perfect especially with a sense of fun and irony, considering all the flies I'll have to contend with in the Australian outback during the summer months. More importantly, it will be a lovely reminder of you! It's so easy to make:

- Please use only 100% cotton, solid white fabric for the background and any clear, jewel-tone print or solid fabric for the half-square triangle units and center square.
- It would mean so much if you would sign your name with the city/state or country where you live in the white areas using a Pigma Pen or permanent fabric ink pen.
- Also, please add a note, blessing, or any kind words in the white background areas. I'd love for you to share where/when you took a class from me or a meaningful incident about a way in which I may have impacted your life. Those words will mean so much to me!


9½" x 9½" unfinished

How to make it:

- Cut 4 – 3½" x 3½" squares from white background fabric.
- Cut 1 – 3½" x 3½" square from a jewel-tone print fabric.
- Cut 2 – 3 7/8" x 3 7/8" squares from white background fabric AND a jewel-tone print fabric. Cut these squares once diagonally, as shown.
- Place a white triangle and a jewel-tone triangle right sides together (RST) and stitch on the long side using a ¼" seam allowance. Press the seam away from the background fabric.
- Make four half-square triangle units (HSTs). These units should measure 3½" x 3½" unfinished.
- Sew the HST units and squares together into rows and then sew the rows into a block. Press the seams towards the background fabric squares.
- The block should measure 9½" x 9½".
- Sign the block with your name and where you live in the white background areas, plus any other words you'd like to share!
- Send it no later than December 1, 2021.
