

Cutting chart and overview

Block	Chart placement	Ruler(s) needed	Cut:
	Block 1	Precision Jelly Roll or Precision Precuts Ruler	Background fabric: • 2 - 2½" strips; subcut 21 - 2½" squares. From a variety of the UpWords print fabrics: • 21 - 2½" squares. • Construct 10½ four-patch units measuring 4½" x 4½"
	Block 2	Precision Flying Geese & HST Ruler Precision Jelly Roll or Precision Precuts Ruler	Background fabric (with strips folded RST): • From 1 - 2½" strip (and leftover 2½" strip from making four-patch units,) cut 18 - 2½" PAIRS of Side B triangles. Floating Yellow and Blue: • Cut 5 - 2½" Side A triangles. Floating Aqua and Rose: • Cut 4 - 2½" Side A triangles. • Construct 18 Flying Geese units measuring 2½" x 4½".


Month #1 - Using Rulers & Sewing Flying Geese and HST Units



Block #1

To make four-patch blocks:

- Pair background square with print fabric square with right sides facing, seam together with ¼ inch seam.
- Press seam to printed side, as illustrated by the red arrow in diagram.
- Match 2 2 piece units together with right sides facing, nest seams, stitch together. Press the seams as indicated by red arrows in the diagram at right. Make 10 and $\frac{1}{2}$ units
- Four-patch units should measure 4½" x 4½".
- Square-up if necessary.
- Combine into groups of four-patch units as shown.







Make 1 of each strip unit with fabric placement as shown.




Block #2

To make Flying Geese units:


- Construct the Flying Geese (FG) units with Side B background fabric triangles and the Floating print fabric Side A triangles as shown in the diagram. For Full Flying Geese Instructions-See Month 1: Project Overview pg.5-7
- Press the seams toward the Side B background fabric triangles, as shown by red arrows, at right.
- **FG** units should measure 2½" x 4½" unfinished.
- Trim dog ears and square-up if necessary.
- Combine the **FG** units into units as shown.
- Press the seams in the **FG** units as shown by the red arrows.
- Set aside until Month 6 for quilt top assembly.



Make 1 of each strip unit with fabric placement as shown.
